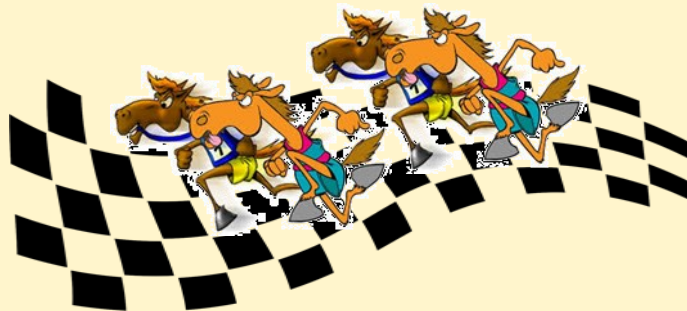

10 patients have been successfully recruited to the PRaM-GBM trial so far, all from Addenbrooke's Hospital. With 3 new sites now open, we are enthusiastic that these figures will be on the rise and climbing the ladder at a steady pace.

Non-Substantial Amendment:

A minor protocol amendment has been submitted and recently approved by the HRA, which includes:

- ◆ further clarification added to section 9: MR Imaging - the DTI-MRI research scans must be acquired at the same field strength.
- ◆ an increase in the time frame for the pre-radiotherapy research scan (within 6 weeks prior to starting radiotherapy).

Documentation will be circulated to sites shortly for confirmation of local C&C and instructions provided for implementation of this amendment.

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
